

Smyth garners awards for two label print projects

ST. PAUL, MN - November 13, 2008 /For immediate release/-- Smyth Companies, Inc., a label printer based in Minnesota, has been doubly honored by Flint Group-Narrow Web for superior printing. Smyth submitted two projects for consideration in Flint's 4th Annual Print Awards which recognize excellence in narrow web printing. The winning entries were a shrink-sleeve label that Smyth printed for The Dial Corp., and a promotional label printed for Coors Brewing Company. Submissions were judged by a panel of print industry experts based on strict criteria, including; registration, smoothness of dot/vignette, overall print quality, and degree of difficulty. The awards were presented in October at the Labelexpo 2008 trade show in Chicago.

Flint Group-Narrow Web is a supplier of inks and coatings to the narrow web printing industry. Flint is based in Sweden and has North America locations in the U.S. and Canada.

Smyth is one of the largest label producers in the U.S. In addition to package labels and P.O.P. displays, Smyth produces in-pack and on-pack promotional labels and application equipment. The company has headquarters in St. Paul, Minnesota, and operates seven production facilities located in Minnesota, Virginia, and Colorado. Smyth employs approximately 380 people.

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
